




Help the family get to the zoo!










(girl name 1) Woke up very (adjective). It was her first time going to the 200.









How to Draw An Elephant












Draw the ears. Draw two ovals on either side of the circle. These two ovals should overlap with the top circle and slightly with the bottom.



Clean up and draw the trunk. Erase the lines of the ears that overlap with the head and the body. Draw two curved parallel lines from the bottom of the head. Connect the lines at the end of the trunk.



Draw the legs. Erase the line at the bottom of the head where the trunk starts. Draw two small from the body and connecting them at the bottom in a horizontal line for the front leg for each front leg. Draw a vertical line from the body and a horizontal line to the front leg for each back leg. You should have two front legs and two back legs.



Add features. Make two dots on the elephant's face for the eyes. Erase just a little bit of the lines at the top of the head where the ears are. Add curved lines along the trunk. Add curved horizontal lines at the bottom of the legs for the elephant's feet. Color and decorate when done!

A: Female












